## *CONSECRATION SUNDAY 2016*

**Consecration Sunday, October 23, 2016**

Consecration Sunday, October 23rd, is the day we secure our future by consecrating the estimate of our financial giving for 2017 as an act of worship together. This will be done privately and confidentially by completing an "Estimate-of-Giving" card, bringing it forward and placing it in a basket on the Lord's Table. This is completely voluntary. No one should feel compelled or coerced to come forward. We offer this, however, as an act of worship to remind ourselves that we belong, body and soul, to God. Those who are not able to be with us on October 23rd will receive an "Estimate-of-Giving" card in the mail so they can participate just as fully.

Let me be quick to add that our giving is not a duty, nor an obligation, but rather a privilege, given to us by God so that we might show our gratitude and live out our faith. The Bible teaches that our giving should be regular (1 Corinthians 16:2), proportional (2 Corinthians 8:12), and sacrificial (Mark 12:43-44). When we give regularly, proportionally, and sacrificially, regardless of the amount, we show our dependence on God. Giving is just one of the spiritual disciplines that forms our faith and allows it to grow. Giving, living our lives dependently upon God, and growing in faith are all acts of worship and discipleship! Our giving is not a contest, nor a competition. Our giving is a way of life that allows us to express our gratitude and to rely more fully on God our creator, redeemer and sustainer. As you consider what your commitment will be for 2017, I ask that you do so intentionally, prayerfully, and thankfully.

Our Session has used your financial gifts wisely this year in our ministry together and it needs to know, as accurately as it can, the financial resources we can expect to have available to us for the coming year. The effectiveness of our church's mission and ministries next year depend on the initiative and commitment of you, our members and friends. Please do whatever you need to do to be present on October 23rd!

## *Welcome!*

We are pleased to introduce you to Dr. Gay Holmes Spears, who will begin her ministry as New Hope's next Director of Music Ministries.

The unanimous choice of the Director of Music Ministries Search Committee, Gay comes to us with an impressive amount of education and experience. Over the past two-plus decades, Gay has served Methodist, Episcopal and Presbyterian congregations as the director of music and/or accompanist. Most recently, Gay served as the Music Director and Organist at the Faith Des Peres Presbyterian Church in Frontenac, Missouri. Gay's reference there, Faith Des Peres' pastor, could not find enough good things to say about her. Gay holds a Bachelor of Music in Music Education from the University of Tennessee at Martin; a Master of Music in Piano Performance from the Arkansas State University; and a Doctor of Musical Arts in Music Composition from the Memphis State University. She has served as an Adjunct Instructor in the Department of Music at Webster University and currently holds that position at St. Louis University.

Gay's continuing education has included participation at conferences and workshops of the American Choral Directors' Association, the Missouri Choral Directors' Association, and the Presbyterian Association of Musicians, along with seminars with noted composers and leaders in the field of music in worship.

## *And Farewell*

After a while, some things are so sure and certain we can't imagine them any other way. And then a letter like this arrives in the mail that makes us realize times do change and life marches on, whether we like it or not. So in the spirit of changing times, I write to share with you that Mike Greene, New Hope's accompanist of 20 years, will be retiring. His last Sunday with us will be November 20, 2016.

Mike is New Hope's longest-serving employee. He began his ministry among us in late 1996. I don't know that he has ever uttered a word in worship, but by my best estimate Mike has led 1,820 services of worship here at New Hope, not counting weddings and funerals. Mike will also be retiring from his "day job" where he works in the computer support industry. He learned to play the piano as a boy at his grandmother's knee and his love of music became his vocation, his calling, his ministry in Christ's church. Mike's giftedness and raw talent are well known. I know people who sit on the "piano side" of the sanctuary specifically to be closer to hear and watch Mike play. As a pastor, I know I take for granted how well Mike is able to weave the whole of the service together with his music and I can't imagine anyone else in his seat.

I don't know if he planned his departure date on purpose, but his last Sunday "on the bench" (November 20) is the last Sunday of the church's liturgical year, what we know as the Reign of Christ Sunday. From that perspective, he's certainly going out on a high note and I hope you will join me in celebrating Mike's long-tenured ministry among us at a luncheon in his honor immediately following the 11:00 service of worship on that day. Also, the Worship, Music & the Arts Committee is planning a gift from the congregation and invites you to contribute to it.
