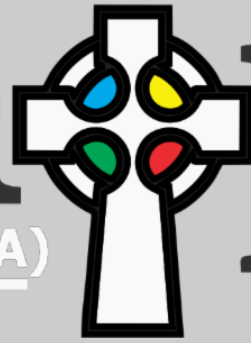

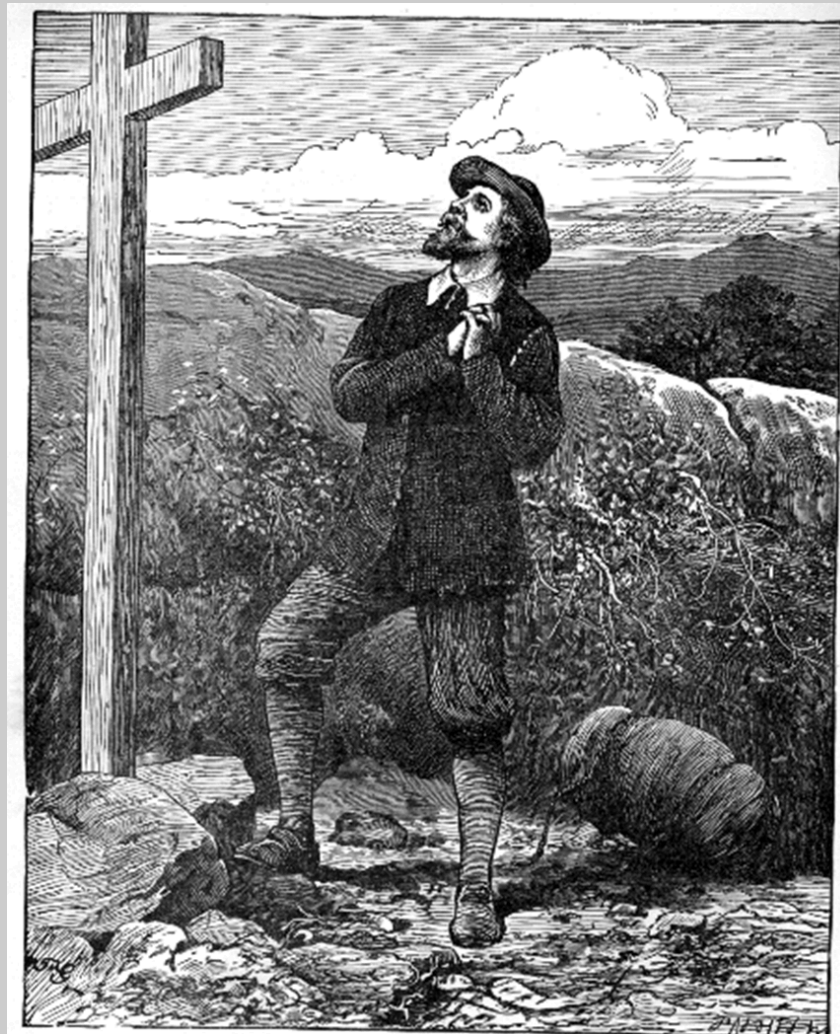

This Sunday, our Adult Sunday School class invites you to change that by making a New Year's resolution to read a timeless Christian classic: John Bunyan's *The Pilgrim's Progress*. This allegorical story follows Christian on his journey from the City of Destruction to the Celestial City, reflecting the spiritual pilgrimage each believer undertakes. Along the way, Christian faces doubt, temptation, failure, and encouragement—experiences that mirror our own walk of faith. Reading it together will deepen our understanding of Scripture, enrich our spiritual imagination with enduring images like the Slough of Despond and Vanity Fair, and invite us to reflect on where we find ourselves on the journey.
